To: DuPont Secure Environmental Treatment Customers,

This letter is to inform you that DuPont Secure Environmental Treatment (SET) will discontinue the acceptance of commercial bulk (truck and rail) wastewater for treatment at the Chambers Works facility in Deepwater, New Jersey

Over the last several years, SET has experienced declining commercial wastewater volumes as a result of industry's successful waste minimization efforts and regulatory initiatives. This decision to discontinue the commercial business is based on these market trends and the resulting current and projected SET business profitability. We are announcing it at this time to allow customers time to identify and qualify appropriate alternate treatment options. The transition will be staged as follows:

- Wastewater treated at the Organic Recovery Operation unit (OREO, Steam Stripper) will end effective October 21, 2011.
- All remaining current commercial wastewater treated directly at the Wastewater Treatment Plant (pump pit, heavy metals, secondary, etc.) will discontinue effective March 30, 2012.
- DuPont will continue to accept and treat qualified shipments of commercial wastewater up to these effective dates.

For more than 35 years, DuPont SET has applied its unique science and technology to safely and effectively treat wastewater at the Chambers Works site. We deeply appreciate our valued customers and regret any inconvenience this decision may cause. We have begun contacting customers directly to answer any questions and provide whatever assistance we can.
