# DuPont™ Escort® XP and Telar® XP Herbicide Recommendations for Control of Invasive Species



## Application information

**Broadcast ground applications:** Use 20-40 GPA when applying DuPont™ Escort® XP or Telar® XP. Select a spray volume and delivery system that will ensure thorough coverage and uniform spray pattern.

**Spot applications:** Mix 1 gram of Escort® XP or Telar® XP per gallon of water along with a suitable adjuvant. Spray to the point of wetting the entire surface of the target weeds, approximately 35 gallons of solution per acre.

Invert spray applications also are recommended. These applications are low volume and waterless.

**Aerial applications:** Use a minimum of 3 gallons. Follow the label for drift management precautions.

**Spray adjuvants:** To improve postemergence weed control, a high quality spray adjuvant should be added at the manufacturer's recommended rate, such as methylated seed oil or a blend with an organosilicone component at the rate of ½ to 1% v/v mixture.
