Use recommendations

Use rate for pasture and rangeland

For control of broom snakeweed, apply Cimarron® MAX at Rate II in the fall. Applications in the spring or with Rate I will provide suppression of broom snakeweed.

Cimarron® MAX rate	Cimarron® MAX Part A rate (oz/A)	Cimarron® MAX Part B rate (pt/A)	Cimarron® MAX acres treated
Rate I	0.25	1	20
Rate II (fall application)	0.50	2	10

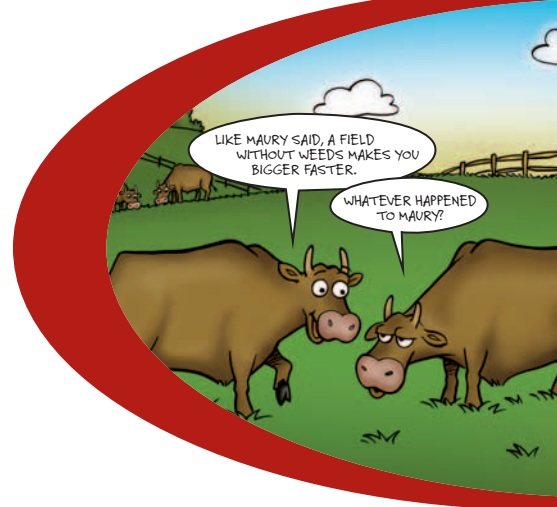
Note: Do not apply more Cimarron® MAX than the equivalent of 1½ ounces per acre of Cimarron® MAX Part A per acre per year.

Fescue and timothy can be sensitive to Cimarron® MAX applications. Refer to label for use directions before using Cimarron® MAX on fescue or timothy.

Do not use on bentgrass or susceptible grass pastures such as carpetgrass, Matua bromegrass or St. Augustinegrass.
