- Consistent residual and contact control that allows you to spray early and plant into a cleaner seedbed.
- Contact plus residual activity allowing your post application to be made closer to crop canopy and help reduce the number of in-crop glyphosate applications.
- Reliable control even under cool, wet conditions.
- Consistent burndown in no-till.

Rate recommendations

When weeds are < 3" tall
Envive™ 3.5-4.0 oz/A
+ 1% v/v COC

When weeds are > 3" tall
Envive™ 3.5-4.0 oz/A
+ 0.25% v/v NIS
+ glyphosate

Application information

- 2,4-D LVE is optional, except when controlling certain weeds. See weed chart (on back) and/or the label for complete list.
- In fields with a composite soil pH of 7.0 or less, higher rates of Envive™ can be used up to 5.3 oz/A.
- For variable pH soils in the state of Virginia where the composite pH of a field exceeds 7.0, use 2.5 oz/A of Envive™ for burndown and limited residual control of labeled weed species.
- Envive™ can be applied early spring following ground thaw, up to three days after planting.
- Can be used in all tillage systems.
- Can be used alone or tank mixed with products such as glyphosate to enhance burndown of emerged winter annual weeds.
- For glyphosate-tolerant soybeans, follow with an in-crop application of glyphosate. As needed, add products such as DuPont™ Synchrony® XP, Classic® or Assure® II herbicides to broaden weed control spectrum.
