Lannate® can be applied by air or ground equipment, and its low-use rates make it extremely cost-effective.

## Here's how it works

For most insects, apply 1/4 to 1/2 pound per acre of DuPont™ Lannate® SP or 3/4 to 1 1/2 pints per acre of DuPont™ Lannate® LV.\*

### ■ Controls a wide range of pests.

Lannate® is effective on a wide range of insects attracted to sweet-corn fields. These include the fall armyworm, armyworms, earworms (ovicide/ larvicide), European corn borer, corn rootworm (adult beetles), flea beetles, picnic beetle, aphids, variegated cutworm and beet armyworm.

### ■ Easy-to-use formulations.

Lannate® is available as a liquid (LV) and as a water-soluble powder (SP) in water-soluble bags. The inner bag stays sealed until dropped into water. It then dissolves completely, minimizing the risk of applicator contact. The water-soluble packaging also eliminates dust and spills.

\* Both Lannate® SP and Lannate® LV can be applied by air or ground equipment. Add a wetting agent to improve coverage.

### Recommendations and precautions

- Check fields early. Fall armyworms can ruin sweet corn. Do not wait for readily visible damage to occur. Best control will be obtained on small worms before their numbers build up. Thorough spray coverage is essential for good control. Because fall armyworms often feed in the whorls, ground application gives the best coverage, especially when nozzles are directed at the whorl area.
