Rate recommendation

- **In fields with a composite soil pH of 7.0 or less.***

Fall application:

DuPont™ Canopy® EX 2 oz/A
+ 2,4-D LVE 1.0-2.0 pt/A
+ glyphosate¹

Spring application:

Canopy® EX 1.5-2.0 oz/A
+ 2,4-D 1.0-2.0 pt/A
+ glyphosate¹

When to apply

- Target application after November 1, but before ground freeze-up and up to 7 days prior to planting in the spring.
